Eligibility Open to students registered in Grade 12 that are completing the requirements of a high school diploma and require assistance to advance to a trade's post-secondary

institution (specific to schools listed below).

Applicants must have demonstrated academic process and have shown the desire of advancing into their selected trade throughout Grades 10 to 12.

Applicants are required to submit an original essay (350-500 words) telling of their background and what draws them to a career in trades. They will also highlight, with exemplars, what they have done during their high school years to prepare for this career choice.

Two letters of recommendation are required. Letters may be provided by two school officials or a school official and an employer or a community leader representing a community based business or organization.

Recipient must be registered in one of the following *post-secondary institutions*: Olds College, SAIT, NAIT (only if the course is not offered at SAIT), University of Lethbridge, Lethbridge College and the University of Alberta Agricultural Faculty.

Apply Applicants should consult with their Guidance Counsellor at their high school.

Forms can be obtained from your school administrator(s) and/or Guidance Counsellor.
