Retention of material is coming up as a struggle for students.</li> <li>● Math in particular seems to be a particular challenge for many grade levels.</li> <li>● Suggestion to create junior high options that help students develop fluency with basic numeracy skills.</li> <li>● Request from parents for greater communication (notification of dates and such) regarding PATs.</li> <li>● Inclusion of PAT marks as part of the class mark is determined by teachers on an individual basis. Alberta Education does not require that PAT's make up a certain portion of the student mark.</li> <li>● Some grade 12 students were disappointed that a Physics 30 diploma review course was not offered by the division.</li> </ul>
