Livingstone School Engagement Concerns</li> <li>Questions around the catchment area for Livingstone expanding into CNP? Population of Livingstone school is decreasing (Lori confirmed). The map may not be a reflection of what is actually happening geographically in terms of attendance at the school.</li> <li>Pooling of resources- option classes, only having a few classes at a time doesn't make sense for Livingstone. Halton having a few classes split or online.</li> <li>Competition with Catholic school in Pincher in terms of numbers is another reason LRSD should look at ways to make efficiencies by having Halton as a hub school.</li> <li>Can a Halton parent attend the Livingstone engagement session? Lori will look into it.</li> <li>HS specializations are limited with competing schools in the area.</li> </ul>

Insurance is costly and the board is exploring options.</li> <li>PC and Lundbreck combined was brought up but it didn't go too far.</li> <li>Sports Feedback- Division office has hired an outside consultant for feedback around athletics in LRSD</li> <li>Do we have to play other schools in sports if we do not want to?
