Find common ground and connection for linking booster and school council for next year. More opportunities for collaboration between groups. Trustee Search- Lori will run again and is open to talking about the process. Livingstone School Engagement Concerns Questions around the catchment area for Livingstone expanding into CNP? Population of Livingstone school is decreasing (Lori confirmed). The map may not be a reflection of what is actually happening geographically in terms of attendance at the school. Pooling of resources- option classes, only having a few classes at a time doesn't make sense for Livingstone. Halton having a few classes split or online. Competition with Catholic school in Pincher in terms of numbers is another reason LRSD should look at ways to make efficiencies by having Halton as a hub school. Can a Halton parent attend the Livingstone engagement session? Lori will look into it. HS specializations are limited with competing schools in the area.

We still do not have our support staff allocation (EA's) for next year from Division Office.

PC will be explored as a Community Project. FACES registration going well- 3 year program now. 600 plus spots available. Skills competition- Many people placed Inclusive Ed Director- shared some thoughts with board around inclusive Ed in the division. Livingstone Leaders- Presented to the board International travel is postponed and is Canada only for the time being. Insurance is costly and the board is exploring options. PC and Lundbreck combined was brought up but it didn't go too far. Sports Feedback- Division office has hired an outside consultant for feedback around athletics in LRSD Do we have to play other schools in sports if we do not want to? Decision would go to a league. New superintendent? Applications end this month, shortlist to follow.
